ONE Programme: Leadership is about investing in young adult leaders in the Methodist Church. We do this through partnering with churches and projects across the Methodist Connexion offering funded placements for young adults to work with them for one year. The focus for these placements is on making new disciples, pioneering and church planting and evangelism. The young adults train as part of a cohort with other young adults doing similar faith sharing roles, including Cliff Years and reflect on their placements. Hi Everyone we are up and running Hurrah!!!

Thank you all so much for supporting this Appeal for Mamie Martin Fund. We are already up to 37% of monies for the first years education, for the six girls we are sponsoring. Term does not start until January 2022. By then we may have raised the first years fees and be well into the second year of fees. Wouldn't that be amazing?

It only needs £500 per annum, from each church in the circuit to raise the whole amount over four years. That is 10 people in each church giving just £2 per week. That does not include the Gift Aid that can be collected on behalf of Mamie Martin by Virgin (for some of the donations) which will add to the sum.

How often are you scratching your head when friends and family want to give you a birthday present or a Christmas present? Instead of a bunch of flowers that fade or a box of chocolates that add to your waistline, signpost them to our Virgin Money giving Scheme for Mamie Martin and they can donate on your behalf. This is already happening. What could be more worthwhile than giving girls an education, who would otherwise be married early, used to work in the fields or look after siblings? Many of these girls are orphans. To be able to give them an education so that they may be able to go to University or get good jobs, is a gift in itself.
